

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER
MONITORING REQUIREMENTS NOT MET FOR**

We are required to monitor your drinking water on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During 1/1/2017 to PRESENT, we failed to submit the required number of samples and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

What happened? What is being done? (Describe corrective action)

The West Virginia Office of Environmental Health Services, Compliance and Enforcement Section claims that they did not receive the results that were faxed to their office on August 15, 2016. After being issued a violation (2017-132028) on February 2, 2017 six months after the original test results were faxed to them, we mailed copies of the original test results faxed in August along with "rescind request", it was denied as it is now past the filing date.
